Speaker's abstract:

The assumption that collective memory is coterminous with national culture delimited by territory no longer holds - if it ever did. Population displacement, mass culture, and the spread of communications technology have deepened and accelerated the migration of memories from the individual to the community and from one community to another. This lecture will analyze the transnational and transgenerational migration of memory through case studies drawn from the experience of historical trauma in Lithuania during the twentieth century.
