## **PANELS**



Work in progress. We invite students currently working on their BA thesis to present their research. Format: 10-15 min. oral presentation.



**Rethinking my research.** We invite recently graduated students to share their BA thesis and/or rethink them from different perspectives. Format: 10-15 min. oral presentation.



Thinking out loud. Thinking about a catchy topic, but not sure what to do with it yet? Let's talk! We invite undergraduate students to share their ideas on a topic that they are interested in. Format: 5-7 min. 'blurb'.

- → Lithuanian Literature
- → Comparative Literary and Cultural Studies
- → Literary and Gender Studies
- → Literary and Media Studies

Abstract length: for the panels Work in progress and Rethinking my research 150 words max. For the panel Thinking out loud a blurb of 50 words max.
