

Utrecht Network Young Researcher's Grant - Application Guidelines for Students

The Utrecht Network Young Researcher's Grant is for self-organised mobility at one of the [Utrecht Network partner universities](#). The grant is limited to thesis research on MA and PhD level. Students are allowed to take courses as well, but priority will be given to "only-research" students.

Prerequisites:

- MA/PhD level
- length of stay: 1 - 6 months (mobility is not restricted to semesters, but is also possible during the holidays).
- mobility period within 1 December 2014 and 31 December 2015.
- Students, who are eligible for an ERASMUS grant cannot apply for this grant.

Grant:

- 1000 euro.

Application documents (must be handed in at the UN contact person of the home university):

- Application form
- Letter of Motivation
- Letter of Recommendation by supervisor/programme coordinator
- Letter of Acceptance (by an academic supervisor/coordinator at the host institution)

Application deadline:

October 15th (the universities can set the different internal application deadline, so students should check it with the home university UN contact person)
